Dr. Marchini's current research focus includes geriatric dentistry, and patient satisfaction with dental treatments. Dr. Marchini is also interested on researching about the best way to teach dentistry. He has published seven textbooks, 16 book chapters and 176 peer-reviewed articles, including those written in both Portuguese and English languages. A hundred and three of those articles were included in the Scopus database, and have received 1100 citations, resulting in an h index=18, as of Sept 6 2022.

Dr. Marchini is former chair of the American Dental Education Association's Gerontology and Geriatric Section (2016-2017), and former councilor of the European College of Gerodontology (2014-2017).
